protective Picreator oil. Paste applied to bronze plaque (Powderhall Bronze) on current town hall removed dirt, letters not golden. Powderhall and Arkell must use different technique for letters, background very similar. No cleaning of other

bronze

plaques planned.

Tower Plaque: Celia phoned Carol at Arkell & Hurcombe - never encountered this

problem. Might be possible to renovate. Celia e-mailed photos today showing undamaged plaque after installation and corroded two years later.
